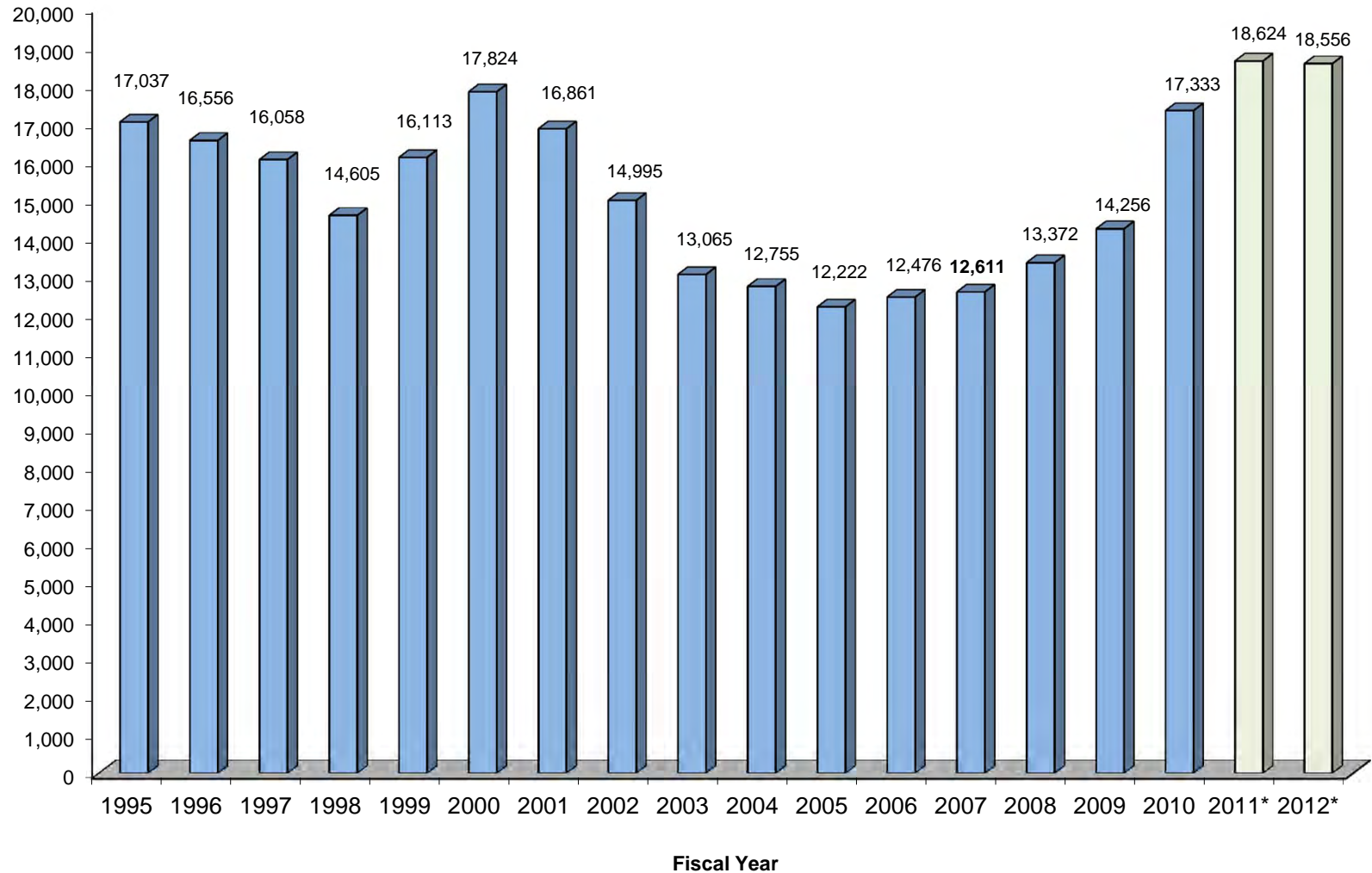

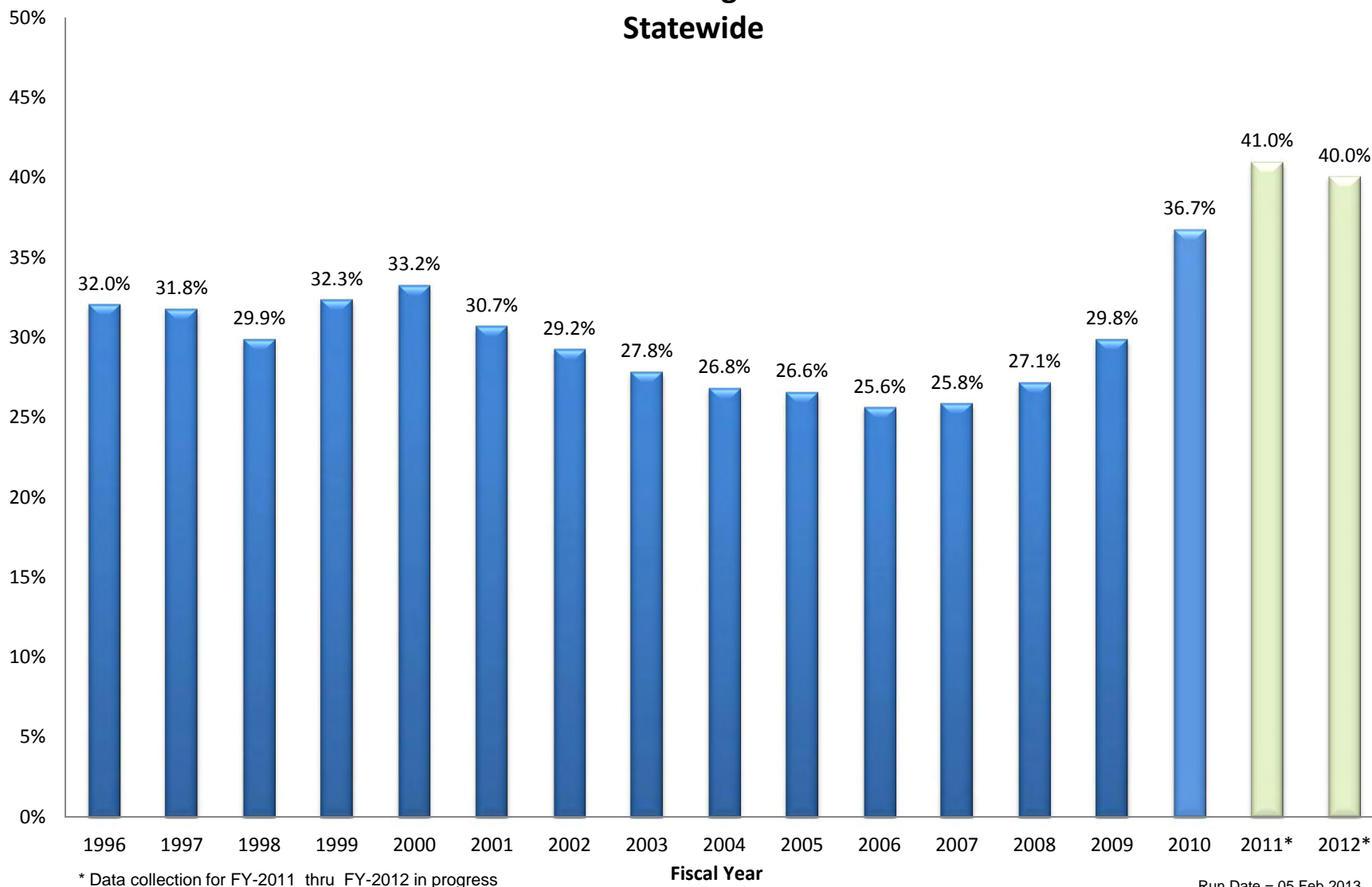

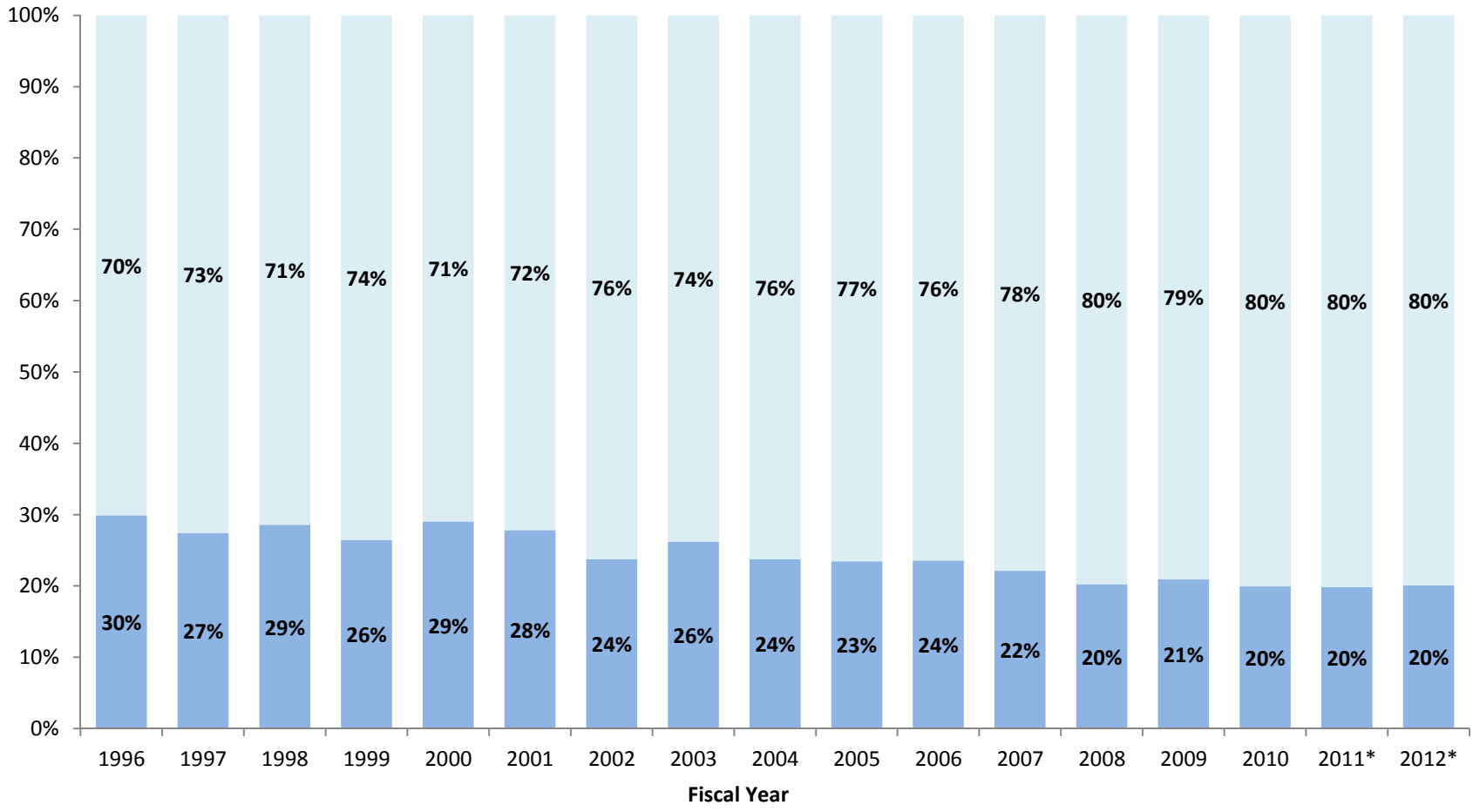

■ Multiple Offense

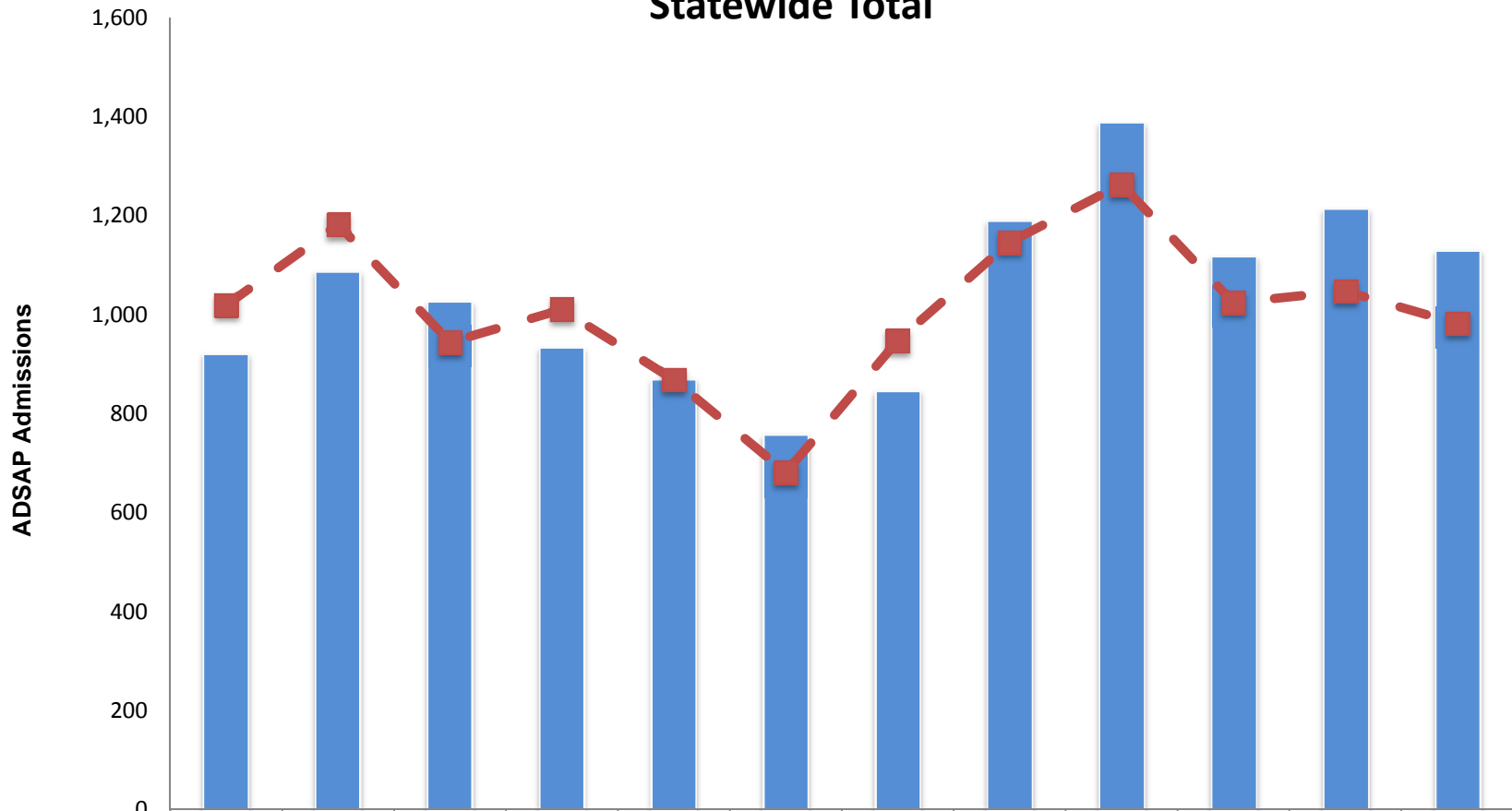

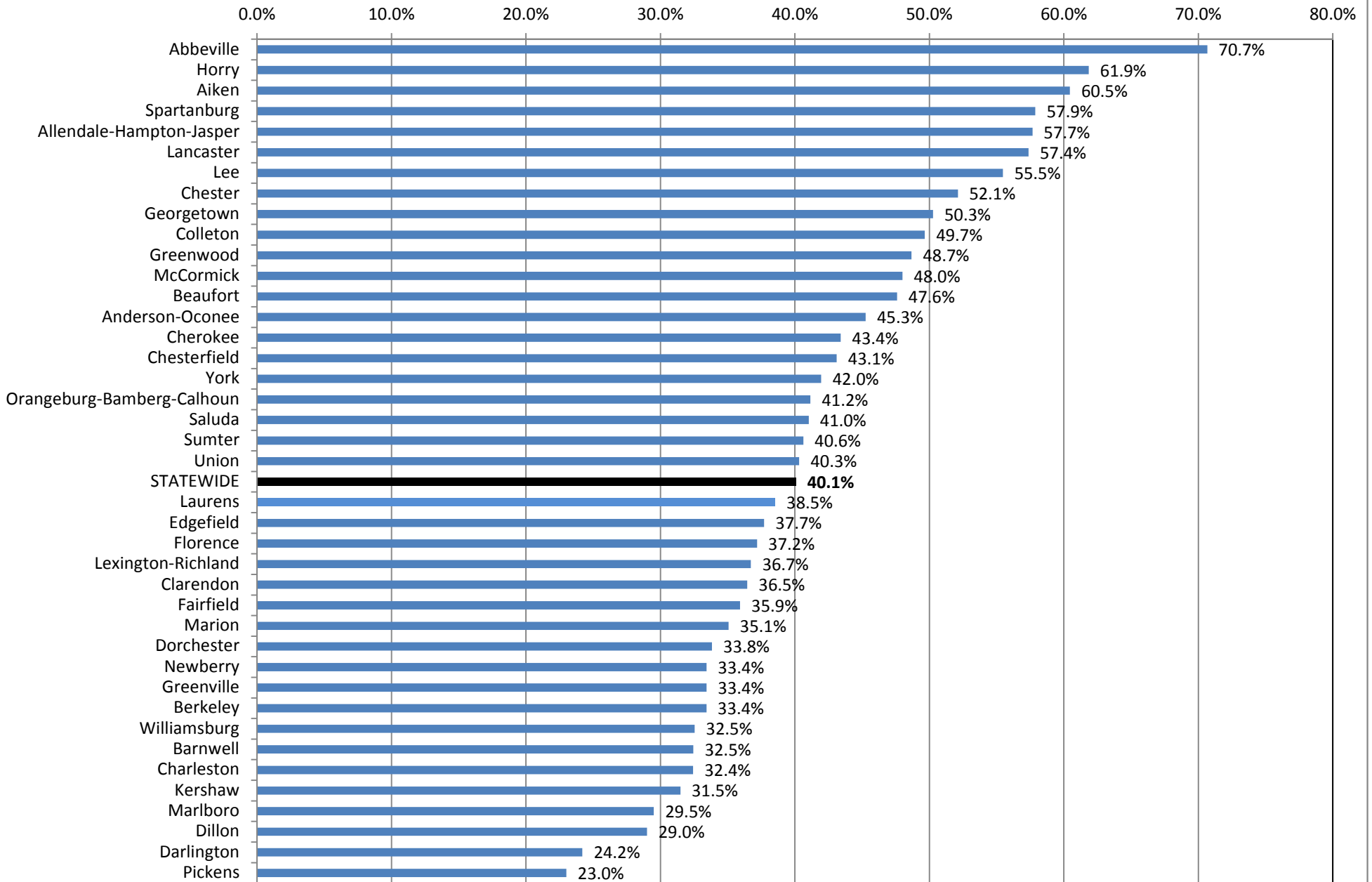

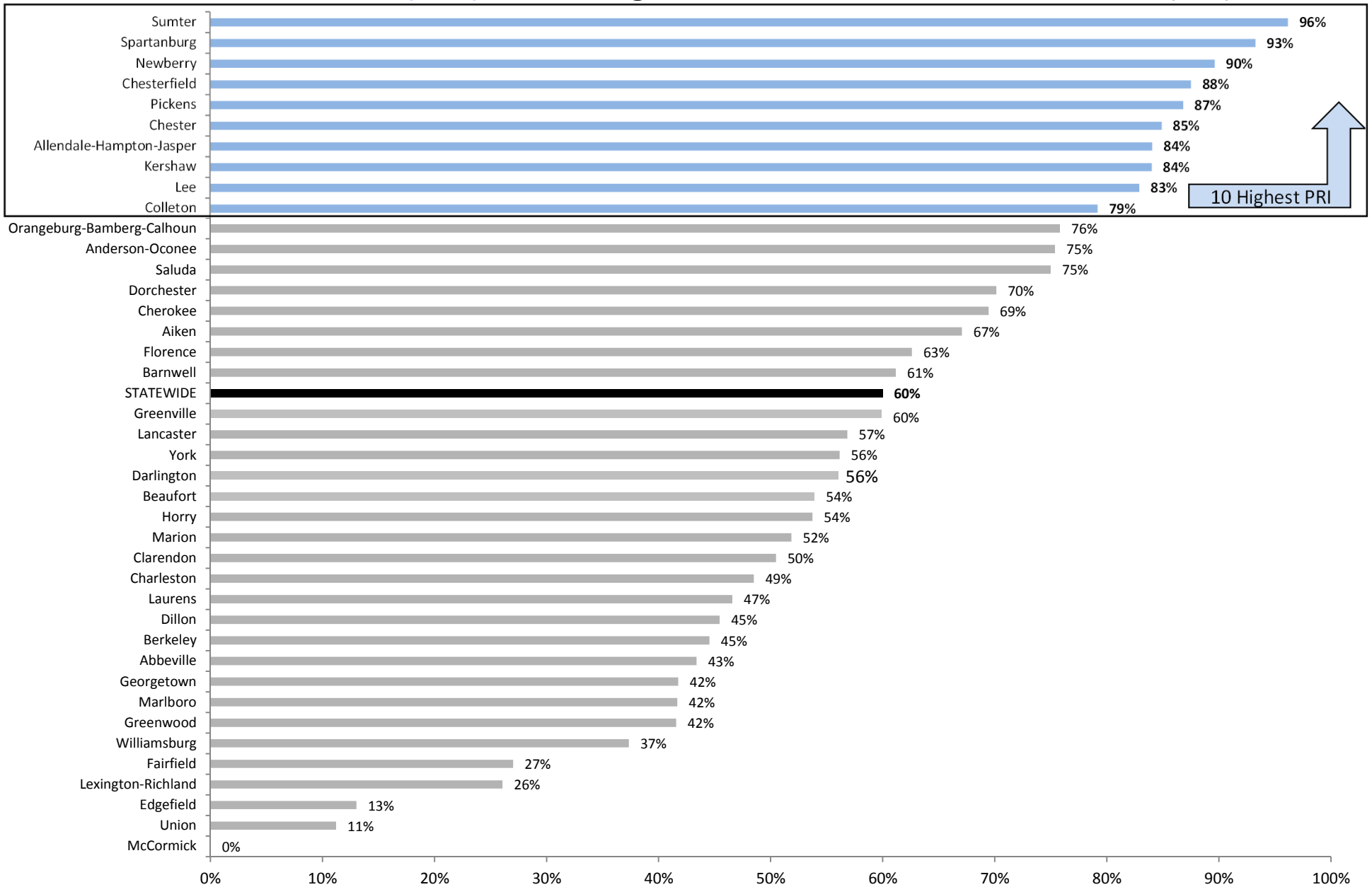
### FY 2012 (YTD): Percentage ADSAP Admissions Represent of an Agency's Total Client Admissions
